Jagiellonian University Medical College is accredited by Polish Commission of Accreditation and recognised by the U.S. Department of Education. On July 27, 2007, the Division of Licensing of the Medical Board of California granted recognition to the English-language programs of the Jagiellonian University Medical College.

Our students are eligible to complete a clinical rotation **in approved teaching hospitals** and our graduates are eligible to enter postgraduate training and apply for licensure in Canada and the US, as well as European countries.

School of Medicine in English

is a part of the Jagiellonian University Faculty of Medicine. It offers dental and medical curricula to students from all over the world.

Classes are run in small groups, in compliance with European and American standards which enables **direct student-teacher and student-patient contact**.

Our Graduates receive a diploma of a physician (equal to Medical Doctor or Dental Doctor Degree) that allows them to apply for residency programs in their home countries.
