English-language Medical Doctor degree program and Doctor of

Dental Surgery degree program that stand in compliance
with Polish, European Union and North American standards. Graduates
of these programs receive MD degree approved internationally.

Jagiellonian University Medical College is accredited by Polish Commission of Accreditation and recognised by the U.S. Department of Education.

Our students are eligible to complete a clinical rotation **in approved teaching hospitals** and our graduates are eligible to enter postgraduate training and apply for licensure in Canada and the US, as well as European countries.

School of Medicine in English

is a part of the Jagiellonian University Faculty of Medicine. It offers dental and medical curricula to students from all over the world.

Classes are run in small groups, in compliance with European and American standards which enables **direct student-teacher and student-patient contact**.

Our Graduates receive a diploma of a physician (equal to Medical Doctor or Dental Doctor Degree) that allows them to apply for residency programs in their home countries.
